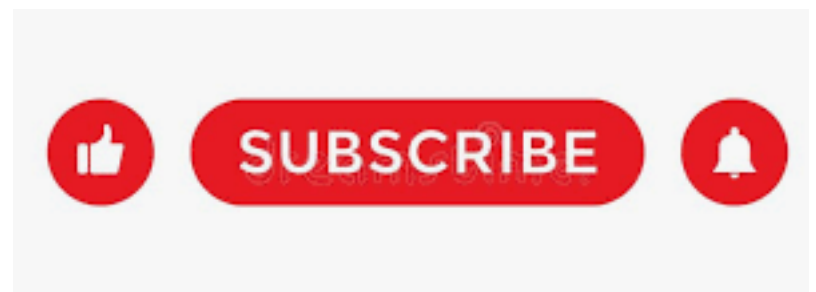

## How do you recognize well-fed young Hyacinth macaws?

We are an outreach and placement program which places into safe custody, parrots which are abandoned, abused, or in need of a home for any reason. Parrots are intelligent, highly social and complex beings with lifespans of up to 100 years.

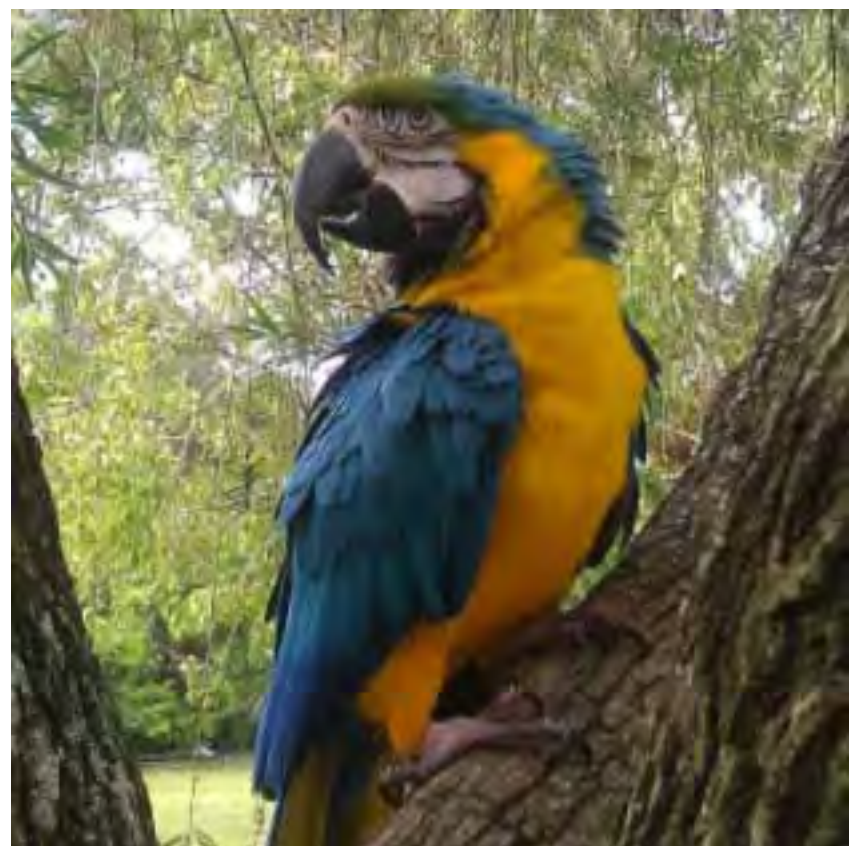
The individual bird's best interest and well being of the present flock will determine if a parrot is accepted into the organization. We actively support networking with other parrot welfare groups, animal welfare organizations, the veterinary community, conservation organizations and the general public. Education is of the utmost importance concerning the well being of a parrot and its ability to successfully live with its human companions.

### **Visit The Bird Gardens of Naples**

The Bird Gardens of Naples is located in the green space of Corkscrew Swamp with a variety of flora, fauna, bees, and butterflies. You will have the opportunity to see, learn, and interact with 100+ birds from origins around the world. If weather allows, groups can enter our large macaw aviary with opportunities to take photos and hold birds. Our guided tours last approximately two hours. Please bring sunscreen, bug spray, and comfortable walking shoes.

Also feel free to bring unsalted nuts to feed the birds, however, no peanuts as they cause diseases in birds. For safety purposes, please stay on the trail and with your tour guide at all times. If you need to leave early, please advise your tour guide. All guided tours begin promptly 15 minutes after the scheduled time. Our gates open 15 minutes before tours and close 15 minutes after, allowing a 30-minute window for all visitors to arrive. Once the gate closes and the tour begins, late visitors will not be allowed in. Please check our address prior to your scheduled tour to ensure enough time for travel.

We do not charge a fee for our educational tours, but donations are greatly appreciated and go along way to help our charity keep the birds happy and healthy.

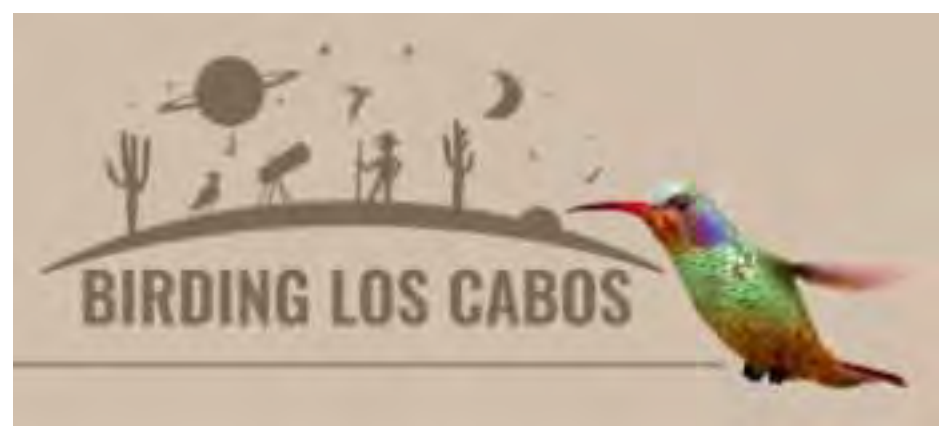

I am often asked at what age you should clip the wings of a new baby bird. This is a very involved question. There are a lot of variables to consider when making this decision. This is not something I just all of sudden decide to do.

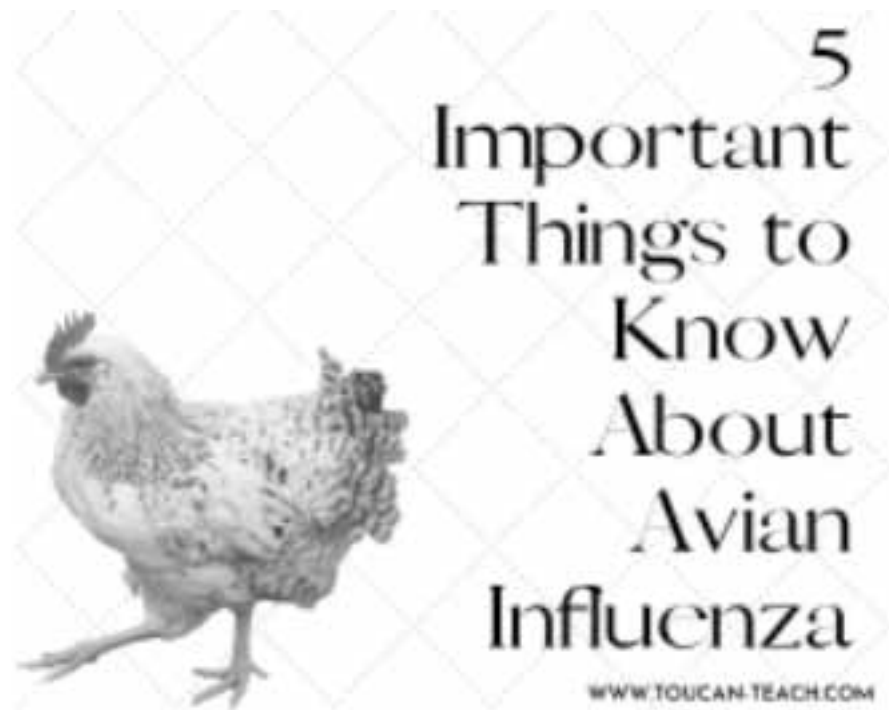
Over the years much has gotten lost as to the real reasons we do things. One of these is clipping wings. Back in the late 1970s and early 1980s very few breeders and hand-feeders clipped their chicks until after they were weaned. The reason for this was to not interfere with the weaning process. Many people think that weaning time is very stressful to a chick. This is hardly the case. It is a very natural smooth process if done correctly.

When your baby is starting to cut back on the amount of food he is taking in, you are reaching the weaning period. When you get him out of the container at feeding time, he no longer lunges to get to the food.

## Preparing Birds for Exhibition

One of the fascinating aspects of budgerigar culture is exhibiting at Local and Open Shows. To be a successful exhibitor of budgerigars, it is necessary to know how to prepare and train them. They need to be spotlessly clean, perfectly steady and display themselves to their best possible advantage.

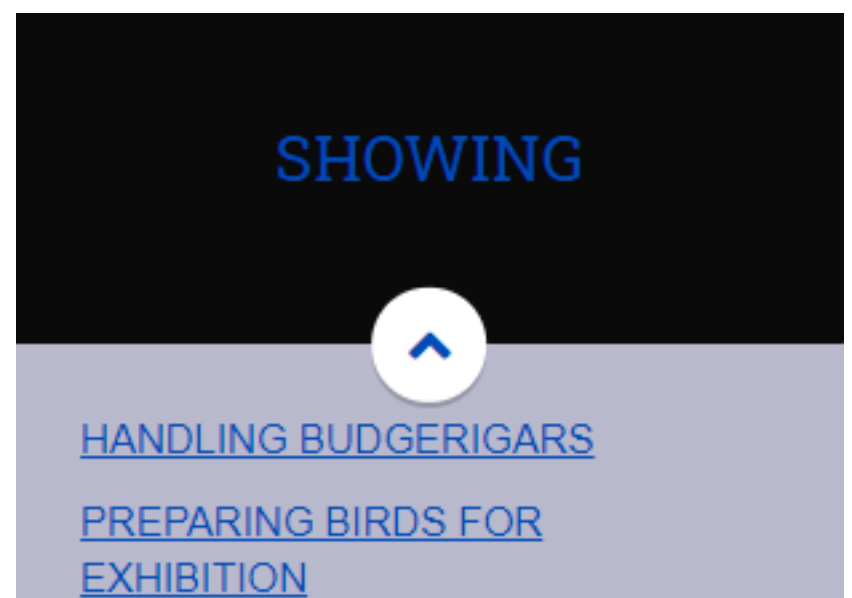
Condition is one of the most important items for a show bird. Many excellent exhibits have been put down just because they were out of condition. It is better to leave the bird at home or to send a substitute, if one is available. Budgerigars differ greatly from many other exhibition birds. The irregularity of their moult often upsets our well laid plans.

Fanciers have different “specialist” techniques for show preparation, but in principle they are basically the same.

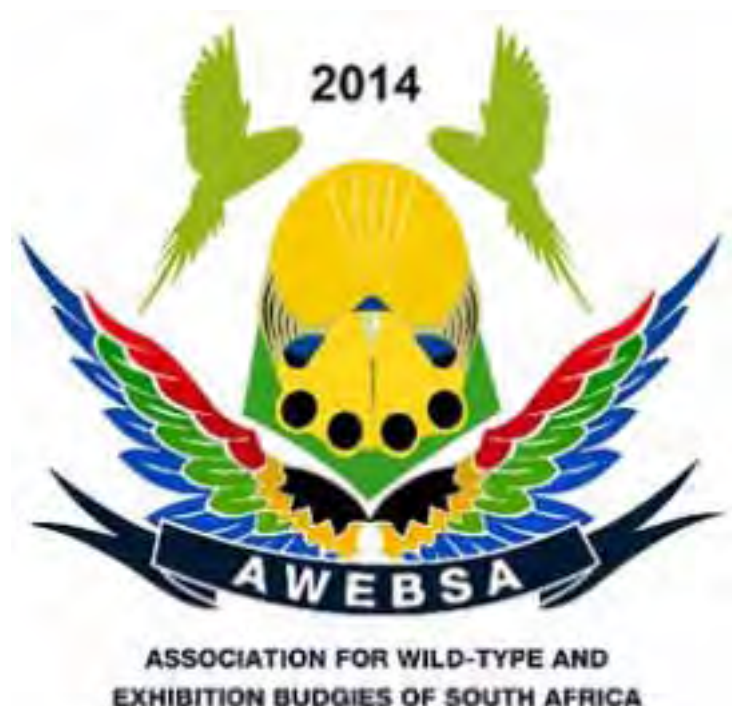
Initially we select the birds, which in our opinion are worthy of being shown. To get the birds steady we cage them in ‘stock’ cages approximately three feet long (1 metre). Do not put cocks and hens together. Apart from fighting it quickly puts young birds out of condition when the sexes are mixed in this way. Six to eight birds to a cage is quite sufficient.

These cages should be kept spotlessly clean as Budgerigars have a habit, after being sprayed, and while preening themselves, to continually rub their heads against the wire fronts. If they are slightly dirty this dirt will soil their masks and heads, very quickly.

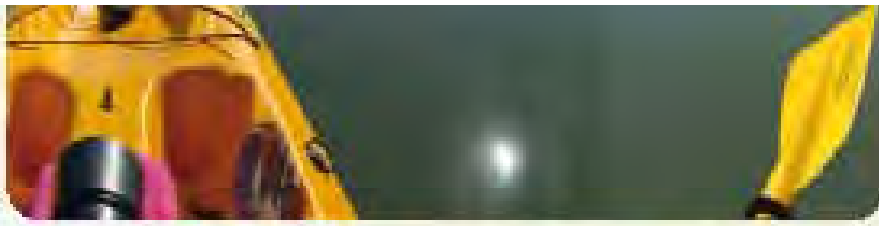

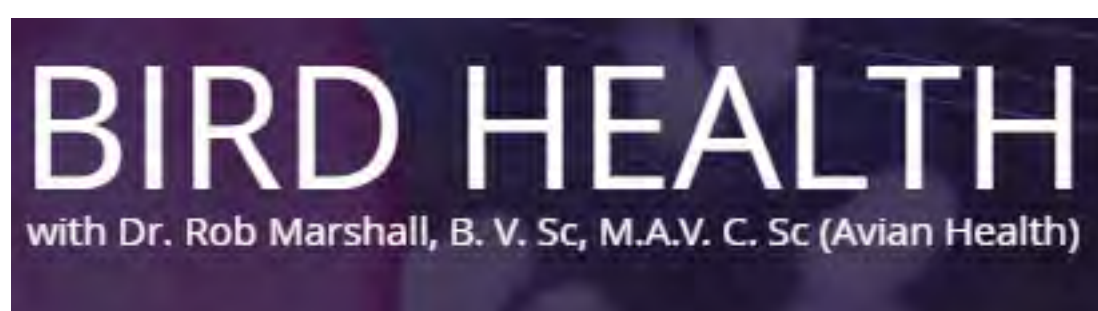

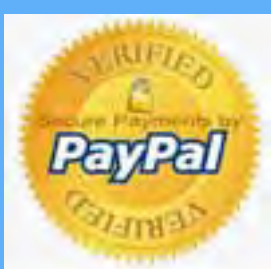
